





Burnet County Republican Women Minutes of General Meeting – March 14, 2024 Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas

Welcome, Call to Order, and Opening Ceremonies: President Mary Jane Avery welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 11:20 A.M., and a lunch was served. Ginger Shuter gave the invocation followed by the pledges to the American and Texas flags led by Kay Stripling. Mary Jane announced that Sue Boss Lee lives in Llano County and has resigned as chaplain. Ginger Shuter will take her place.

Introductions: Mary Jane asked elected officials, precinct chairs, candidates, and guests to introduce themselves. We sang happy birthday for March birthdays.

Approval of Minutes: The February minutes were prepared by Darlene Hargett. They were published in the newsletter. There were no corrections or additions. The minutes stand approved as published.

Treasurer's Report: Carolyn Richmond reported that we currently have \$45,789.53 in our operating account.

Darlene Hargett received a certificate for her organization, leadership, and patience as judge at Agrilife. That location voted the most voters in the county. Mary Jane also thanked Tammy Hullum for organizing the watch party and Gail Teegarden for serving on the Early Ballot Board.
- · Janet Parker and Vicinta Stafford were recognized along with all who helped make the Reagan dinner a success. Thanks to those who brought cookies for the candidate forum and to those who participated in texting on February 19th for the Day of Action Texting Hispanic Voters.

Program: Gail Teegarden introduced our guest speaker, Scott Toland, Special Assistant to President Trump and Assistant Staff Secretary. Scott gave a very informative overview of his life in the Oval Office. He used pictures to illustrate some of his duties. He described his most important duty as that of "gatekeeper" to protect the President where documents were concerned. He told us President Trump's character traits were a great listener, appreciative (saying thank you and good job), and always moving forward. Gail presented Scott with a book titled The American Boomerang by Nick Adams.
