September Meeting Minutes

Burnet County Republican Women Minutes of General Meeting – September 12, 2024 Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas

Welcome, Call to Order, and Opening Ceremonies: President Mary Jane Avery welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 11:35 A.M., and a lunch was served. Ginger Chuter gave the invocation followed by the pledges to the American and Texas flags led by Becky Freitas.

Introductions: Mary Jane asked all elected officials, precinct chairs, and candidates to stand to be recognized. Guests introduced themselves.

Volunteer Sign-Up: Volunteers are needed for door-knocking/driving, Team Texas

Seguin, Lunch & Text, and Trump 47. Mary Jane gave a few minutes for each table to come to the table to sign up.

Approval of Minutes: The April minutes were prepared by Darlene Hargett. They were published in the newsletter. There were no corrections or additions. The minutes stand approved as published.

Treasurer's Report: Carolyn Richmond reported that we have a balance of \$47,595.43 as of August 31. This does not include proceeds from the GOP Picnic which will be split between the BCRW and BCRC.

Approval of Award Disbursements: Mary Jane asked for approval to make the following award disbursements: \$100.00 TFRW Hospitality, \$10,00 Beryl Dowd Leadership Scholarship Fund, and \$200.00 for a 2024-25 TFRW State Scholarship Donation. The motion was made by Carleen Kaurin with a second by Judy Salvaggio. The motion passed.

Membership: Janice Estill reported that we ended 2024 with 129 members.

Nominating Committee: Mary Jane read the portion of the Bylaws that pertain to the Nominating Committee election. Three members and an alternate shall be elected by the membership. Becky Freitas, Libby Edwards, Judy Salvaggio, and Carolyn Richmond were nominated. Susan Doyle made a motion to elect the four candidates with a second by Janet Parker. The motion passed. The committee will select the chair. They will present a slate of officers in October. The slate will be voted on in November with installation in December.




