

Meeting – May 9, 2024 Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Burnet County Republican Women Minutes of General Building – Burnet, Texas

Welcome, Call to Order, and Opening Ceremonies: President Mary Jane Avery welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 11:30 A.M., and a lunch was served. Ginger Shuter gave the invocation followed by the pledges to the American and Texas flags led by Londa Chandler.

Introductions: Kay Stripling introduced the scholarship recipients and their families. Mary Jane asked elected officials, precinct chairs, candidates, and guests to introduce themselves. One new member was also introduced.

Approval of Minutes: The April minutes were prepared by Darlene Hargett. They were published in the newsletter. There were no corrections or additions. The minutes stand approved as published.

Membership: Janice Estill was not in attendance to give a report. Mary Jane reported that we have 123 members.

Tribute to Women Honorees: The BCRW Executive Board recommended that Vicinta Stafford and Gloria Pollard be chosen as our Tribute to Women Honorees. They were voted on unanimously.



Introduction of 2024 Scholarship Recipients: The 2024 scholarship recipients are Riley Arrington, Burnet High School; Audri Poage, Faith Academy; and Ava Carter, Marble Falls High School. Kay Stripling introduced each recipient and gave some information about each one, including the college they will attend and their intended major. They were presented a red rose. State Senator Pete Flores presented each recipient a Certificate of Appreciation from the State of Texas.

Program: Gail Teegarden introduced our guest speaker, State Senator Pete Flores. Senator Flores emphasized that we are not a democracy but a constitutional republic. He stressed the need for Republicans to vote at the local level all the way to federal. He said, "step up, get engaged, and vote." The rural vote keeps Texas red, since the cities are blue. We must work to keep Texas red because if we lose Texas, we lose the country. He listed the accomplishments of the previous legislative session and named several topics to be addressed in the next session. Border security and property tax relief were the largest accomplishments.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:45 with the singing of "God Bless America" led by Carolyn Richmond, newly elected to the Meadowlakes City Council.


