

BCRW Membership Code of Conduct

The following standards and expectations related to membership activity and responsibility are hereby adopted by the Burnet County Republican Women (BCRW). The term "members" and its derivatives are used throughout this document to refer to active and associate members equally.

SECTION 1. Interaction and General Guidelines at Meetings

a) Members are encouraged to socialize and network with other members, speakers, and guests at in-person meetings.

- b) Members shall treat all viewpoints, whether expressed by other members, speakers, or guests, with utmost respect and consideration, even when viewpoints differ, or when passion for a topic is heightened, or when expressing preference or distaste for a candidate or issue.
- c) Members shall refrain from inappropriate behavior on the property of which meetings or gatherings of BCRW are held.
- d) Members posing questions or expressing opinions before an audience at any BCRW meeting or event shall refrain from using foul language, controversial subject matter, or divisive speech.
- e) Members posing questions to a speaker shall be mindful of questions which may make speakers or audience members uncomfortable due to length or convolution of the question. If members need to speak on issues of that matter, the speaker may have time after the meeting if a member wishes to reach out to him or her.
- f) Political literature may not be passed out on the property where meetings are held, but may be placed on a designated table in the foyer or back of the room.

SECTION 2. General Conduct

- a) **Social Media**. Members are encouraged to respectfully express their own political viewpoints and positions on political campaigns and issues. Activities should not suggest representation of BCRW or endorsement by BCRW.
- b) **Bylaws.** Members are expected to abide by the bylaws of BCRW.

Membership Code of Conduct may be adopted or amended without previous notice by a majority vote of members present at any business meeting.







December 2023 Minutes

Burnet County Republican Women Minutes of General Meeting – December 14, 2023 Sylvester H. Reed Memorial Building – Burnet, Texas

Welcome, Call to Order, and Opening Ceremonies: President Mary Jane Avery welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 11:35 A.M., and a lunch was served. Chaplin Sue Boss Lee gave the invocation followed by the pledges to the American and Texas flags led by Damon Beierle.

Introductions: Mary Jane asked elected officials, precinct chairs, candidates, and guests to introduce themselves.

Approval of Minutes: The October and November minutes were prepared by Darlene Hargett. They were published in the December newsletter, and a copy was placed on each table. There were no corrections or additions, so the minutes stand approved as distributed and published.

Code of Conduct Update: In compliance with TFRW, the Code of Conduct for BCRW has passed out of committee to be voted on by the membership. Janice Estill made a motion, seconded by Lillian Creasy. The motion passed.

Membership: Janice Estill reported that we have 62 members and 20 associates to date with one new member today. Mary Jane encouraged us to invite a friend or gift a membership.

Caring For America: Mary Jane introduced Caroline Ragsdill from the Burnet County Child Welfare Board who spoke about families of foster children needing Christmas

items. Deborah Smith passed around a basket, and \$621 was donated.

Sue Boss Lee discussed Wreaths Across America and invited everyone to attend the laying on of wreaths on Saturday December 16. From the BCRW collection last month, 115 wreaths were purchased. A card with a QR code was on each table. Wreaths can be purchased on this code.

Program: Gail Teegarden introduced our speaker, Zenia Warren, TFRW President Elect. She emphasized voting Republican top to bottom and educating friends about this. One of the main focuses of TFRW is uniting Republican women. She outlined the TFRW Proposals for electing Republicans:

- · Make one million phone calls between mid-January and one week before the November election.
- Register 150,000 new voters.
- · Educate, train, and empower women.
- Get 3,000 women delegates to the RPT Convention.

TFRW Leadership Day is January 27, 2024.

Mary Jane wished all a Merry Christmas. The meeting was adjourned at 12:20 P.M. with the singing of "Jingle Bells."
